

1 **CHAPTER 833. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES**

3 ADOPTED RULES WITH PREAMBLE TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE *TEXAS REGISTER*.

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7 The Texas Workforce Commission (Commission) adopts the repeal of the following sections of
8 Chapter 833, relating to the Community Development Initiatives (CDI) rules, as published in the
9 November 3, 2006, issue of the *Texas Register* (31 TexReg 8979):

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14 **PART I. PURPOSE, BACKGROUND, AND AUTHORITY**

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16 The purpose of the adopted repeal is to eliminate Chapter 833, Subchapter B, relating to the
17 Texas Individual Development (IDA) Account Pilot Project. In 1999, Texas Labor Code
18 §301.068 directed the Commission to create the Texas IDA Pilot Project. The goal of this
19 project was to offer an opportunity for employed, yet economically disadvantaged, individuals to
20 save earned income in order to purchase assets such as a postsecondary education, a home, or a
21 small business. Based on this legislative direction, the Commission adopted Chapter 833,
22 Subchapter B to administer the pilot project.

24 The Commission funded three pilot project consortia to assist eligible low-income individuals in
25 saving for the asset purchases envisioned in the statute. In July 2003, an independent entity
26 began an evaluation of the three IDA pilot projects. The contracts for the three pilot sites expired
27 in February 2005, and the evaluation of the project was completed in April 2005. The
28 Commission submitted the required report to the Legislature and the controlling statute, Texas
29 Labor Code §301.068, expired September 1, 2005. Therefore, Subchapter B of Chapter 833 is
30 no longer required.

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37 The repeal is adopted under Texas Labor Code §301.0015 and §302.002(d), which provide the
