Topic: **Limitation on Services using Fund Source 1 – OneStop**

Date: **June 1, 2006**

This Technical Assistance Bulletin provides Local Workforce Development Boards (Boards) with information on a new edit in The Workforce Information System of Texas (TWIST) regarding OneStop services.

The Texas Workforce Commission is continuing its review of TWIST data due to the implementation of Common Measures. In the most recent review a significant number of training services were documented using the *Fund Source 1 – OneStop* without the use of a sub-fund. The expansion of the services allowable with *Fund Source 1 – OneStop* was intended to be used in conjunction with a sub-fund. As a result the Texas Workforce Commission will implement a new edit in TWIST that limits the services that are available for use with *Fund Source 1 - OneStop* unless a sub-fund is used.

Effective 06/02/2006, if a user tries to enter *Fund Source 1 - OneStop* with the services listed below, and a legitimate sub-fund is not included, an error message will appear informing the user that the service cannot be saved under that fund source.

Services affected by the limited use of the OneStop fund source are:
