**Subject:** **Fiscal Year 2010/Program Year 2009 Workforce Investment Act Allocations and Planning Estimates: Update**

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### PURPOSE:

To provide Local Workforce Development Boards (Boards) with Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/Program Year (PY) 2009:

- allocations for Workforce Investment Act (WIA) formula adult, **dislocated worker**, and youth funds; and
- planning estimates ~~WIA formula dislocated worker funds~~. **for the following workforce funding categories:**
  - **Child Care**
  - **Choices**
  - **Employment Services**
  - **Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program Employment and Training (currently known as Food Stamp Employment and Training)**
  - **Project Reintegration of Offenders**
  - **Trade Act Services**
  - **WIA Alternative Funding for Statewide Activities**
  - **WIA Alternative Funding for One-Stop Enhancements**

### BACKGROUND:

On May 19, 2009, the Texas Workforce Commission (Commission) approved the FY 2010/PY 2009 allocations **for WIA formula adult and youth funds**, and

planning estimates for ~~the above noted funding categories~~ **WIA formula dislocated worker funds adult and youth. On June 9, 2009, the Commission approved the FY 2010/PY 2009 allocations for WIA formula dislocated worker funds, and planning estimates for the above funding categories.** The approved FY 2010/PY 2009 allocations and planning estimates are shown in Attachment 1 to this WD Letter.

**PROCEDURES:**

Boards must use the FY 2010/PY 2009 WIA ~~adult and youth formula~~ allocations to plan the delivery of workforce services that meet the needs of employers and job seekers, and develop strategies for meeting or exceeding their contractual performance targets.

Boards must use the FY 2010/PY 2009 planning estimates for ~~WIA dislocated worker formula funds~~ to assist in planning workforce services until FY 2010/PY 2009 allocations are adopted by the Commission.
