Subject: **Fiscal Year 2010/Program Year 2009 Allocations and Performance Targets—Update**

PURPOSE:

To provide Local Workforce Development Boards (Boards) with updated Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/Program Year (PY) 2009 local workforce development area (workforce area) allocations for child care.

BACKGROUND:

On August 18, 2009, the Texas Workforce Commission (Commission) approved the FY 2010/PY 2009 allocations and performance targets for child care. The Child Care Funds and Child Care Match amounts included in Attachment 1 to this WD Letter have been calculated using the updated Federal Medical Assistance Percentages rate for Federal Fiscal Year 2010. The total child care allocation for each workforce area remains the same, and all local matching targets for each workforce area remain the same as originally noted in WD Letter 33-09.

- replace them with Attachment 1 to this WD Letter.
