Find Answers to Employment and Housing Discrimination Questions

EL PASO – Your right and access to equal employment should not be based on race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin or disability, *and* your right and access to fair housing should not be based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, disability or familial status.

If you suspect employment or housing discrimination, schedule an appointment with a Texas Workforce Commission Civil Rights Division investigator, who will be at the Border Fair Housing and Economic Justice Center, located at 1444 Montana Ave., Suite 100, in El Paso, from Tuesday, April 22nd through Friday, April 25^h from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The investigator will answer any questions regarding employment and housing discrimination.
