Appointment of Chairperson for the Advisory Committee of the Purchasing from People with Disabilities Program

Background

Section 122.0057(a) of the Texas Human Resources Code authorizes TWC's three-member Commission (Commission) to form an advisory committee to help the Commission establish program performance goals and criteria for certifying Community Rehabilitation Programs (CRPs) to participate in the Purchasing from People with Disabilities (PPD) program.

 Section 122.0057 dictates that the advisory committee be composed of 13 members appointed by TWC, as follows:

• four representatives from CRPs that participate in the PPD program

- four representatives from organizations that advocate for individuals with disabilities
- four individuals with disabilities, two of whom are employed by a CRP that participates in the PPD program
- the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission or his or her designee

Section 122.0057(d) requires the Commission to appoint an advisory committee chairperson from among the members serving on the committee. When the role of chairperson is vacant, staff invites current PPD members to submit their interest in serving as chair. Staff gathers information about each interested member and considers additional factors such as opportunity for each of the groups represented by the committee to serve as chairperson and experience of each interested member in performing similar leadership roles.

 Following the resignation of the current PPD advisory committee chair, PPD staff surveyed committee members to determine which members were interested in being considered for appointment as chairperson. Three members expressed interest in serving, one representing advocacy organizations and two representing CRPs.

Decision Points

Staff seeks direction on Commission appointment of Linda Logan, Senior Public Policy Analyst with the Texas Council on Developmental Disabilities as Chairperson of the PPD Advisory Committee. Ms. Logan represents advocacy organizations on the Committee.

Staff also seeks direction on appointment of Ms. Logan to the office of chairperson for a period beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 4, 2021.
