

## **Texas Child Care Magazine**

The Texas Workforce Commission publishes *Texas Child Care* magazine, a training journal for child care workers and preschool teachers. The magazine is published four times a year--March, June, September and December.

Each 48-page issue contains three main sections:

- 1) articles about child development, health and safety, nutrition, guidance, child care as a business, and other topics aimed at improving quality care and education;
- 2) *Texas Parenting News*, a four-page pull-out that providers can photocopy and give to the parents of children in their care; and
- 3) learning activities involving art, language, music, blocks, outdoor play, or other topics that providers can do with children.

Articles are written by experienced teachers or experts in the field. The magazine contains no advertising.

The magazine is mailed free to licensed or registered child care facilities in Texas. By reading the articles and using the ideas, Texas providers can earn credit for self-instructional training. If you are not receiving the magazine or your address has changed, contact the local office of the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services. Your licensing representative will update your information so you will receive the magazine.

If you would like to subscribe, the cost is \$25 a year. Texas residents pay an additional \$2.06 sales tax. A sample copy or back issue, if available, costs \$6.50, plus 54 cents sales tax for Texas residents.
