**COMMISSIONERS' WORK SESSION  
MEETING MINUTES  
Tuesday, April 26, 2011  
2:00 p.m.**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pauken at 2:04 p.m. A quorum was present, including Commissioners Congleton and Alcantar. Texas Workforce Commission staff was also in attendance.

The Commissioners discussed career school program performance monitoring, operations and areas for consideration for possible policy and administrative change. Laurie Biscoe, Deputy Division Director, Workforce State- Operated Services, gave a brief summary of the reporting requirements, performance measurement standards, and corrective action and enforcement options when measurements and requirements are not met.

Larry Temple, TWC Executive Director, reported that Monitoring and Internal Audit are working together to develop a sampling protocol for risk assessment. They are looking into the allowability of using the New Hire Database to determine if recent graduates have been hired in surrounding states. The Career Schools and Colleges Division is developing a rule proposal on accountability measures and other career school requirements for the Commission's approval to be presented on or around the first of June.

John Moore, Director of Regulatory Integrity, clarified a few questions the Commission had regarding the Commission's authority to take enforcement actions for performance and other violations.

Larry Jones informed the Commission that staff is researching the performance and outcome data collected for community and technical colleges and how that information may be used in informing potential students of the options available to them.

Chairman Pauken adjourned the meeting at 2:28 p.m.
