

Help for UI Claimants Running Out of Benefits

Many Unemployment Insurance (UI) claimants have or will soon run out of benefits and have contacted the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) to ask about additional assistance.

Where else can I get help?

You may be able to find help at the following:

- Call the **2-1-1** system to learn more about human services available in your community, such as food banks, rent, and utility assistance, health insurance programs, medical information lines, Meals on Wheels, home health care, and more. Can I get other benefits?

If you have received all of the regular benefits, EUC Tier 1, 2, 3, 4, and Extended Benefits (EB) that you are eligible to receive, no further UI benefits are available to you. You can find more information about the benefit extensions at [Understanding Extended Unemployment Benefits](#).

Will the U.S. Congress extend benefits again?

Congress extended the deadline to qualify for the existing benefits available under Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) and Extended Benefits (EB). Claimants now have additional time to establish a **new** EUC Tier 1, 2, 3, 4, or EB claim.

Congress **did not add additional weeks** of benefits for claimants who previously exhausted EUC Tiers 1, 2, 3, 4, and EB. At this time, Congress is not considering adding additional weeks of benefits for claimants who exhausted all benefits under EUC and EB. **If another extension occurs after you exhaust your benefits, we will notify you by mail**, so make sure we have your correct address.
