

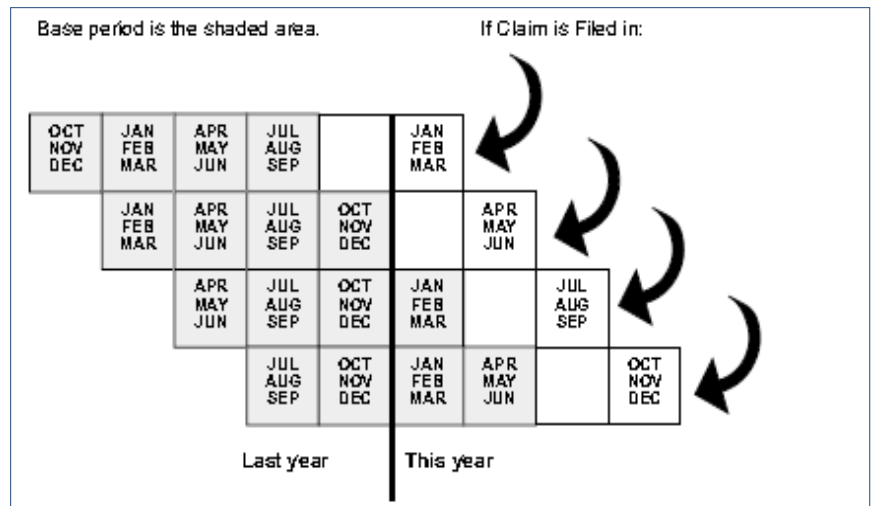


Did you work in another state last year?

If yes, here's how the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) determines where you should apply for Unemployment Benefits.

Step 1: TWC determines your “base period.”

When you apply for benefits, TWC uses the wages you earned in a 12-month **base period** to calculate your unemployment benefits. A **base period** is the **first four** of the **last five** completed calendar quarters before the start date of your claim.



Step 2: TWC determines where you worked during your base period.

Did you work in another state (not Texas) during the 12 months of your base period?

If yes, you will apply for unemployment benefits in **that state**. Find the state in the table below, then go to that state’s Web site or call the number listed to apply for unemployment benefits.

Did you work in several states during your 12-month base period?

If yes, apply for benefits in **any (one) state** where you earned wages, but only submit an application for benefits in **one** state.

Minimum/Maximum Weekly Benefits by State

The following table shows the minimum and maximum unemployment benefit amounts and contact information for unemployment benefits by state. Find the state where you worked, then go to that state’s Web site or call the number listed in the table to apply for unemployment benefits.

NOTE: If you want apply for benefits with Delaware, Massachusetts, or the Virgin Islands, call Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) at 1-800-939-6631. TWC will take your application and send it to the appropriate state.
